STANDARDS OF PROTECTION OF MINORS NEURO PROGRESS CENTER FOR REGENERATIVE MEDICINE

- 1. We are a professional medical entity and we want you to feel good and safe with us.**
- 2. If you did not like anything or felt bad, you can pass it on to Mr. Andrew Peskau or write to the e-mail address: kontakt@neuropostep.pl**
- 3. You go to the examination with your mum or dad. They can always be with you.**
- 4. Before the test, the doctor will explain to you what he will do and why.**
- 5. You can tell the doctor anything, he is here to help you.**
- 6. Knowing what ails you, what you are afraid of or ashamed of can be very important. With this knowledge, your doctor will be able to help you in the best possible way.**
- 7. You can ask the staff and everyone in our clinic questions. They will be happy to answer them.**
- 8. No one can yell at you, make fun of you, touch you without your permission, or photograph you.**
- 9. Whatever happens in your life, you are not alone. These are the round-the-clock phone numbers for people you can trust:**

*Pursuant to Article 10 of the Act, the obligation to introduce the above-mentioned standards must be fulfilled within 6 months from the date of entry into force of the so-called Kamilka Act, i.e. by **15 August 2024**. This is the so-called transitional period to adapt the activities of a given entity to compliance with the Act.*

The obligation to introduce standards for the protection of minors applies to:

- 1. Governing body:*
 - an educational institution referred to in Article 2(1)-(8) of the Act of 14 December 2016, the Law on School Education (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 900). These include, m.in: kindergartens, schools and youth hostels;*
 - other educational, care, upbringing, rehabilitation, religious, artistic, medical, recreational, sports or interest-related establishment, attended or where minors are or may stay;*
- 2. organiser of educational, care, upbringing, rehabilitation, religious, artistic, medical, recreational, sports or related to the development of interests by minors;*
- 3. entities providing hotel and tourist services, as well as other places of collective accommodation, to the extent necessary to ensure the protection of minors.*

The Ministry of Justice has a Team for the Protection of Minors, composed of experts – representatives of various institutions (other ministries, non-governmental organizations, scientific communities, local government units). Its tasks include preparing guidelines for the development of standards and updating these guidelines every 2 years.

Currently, eleven working groups work within the team, which prepare guidelines with sample standards for various types of institutions/activities (nurseries, schools, kindergartens, hotels, day-care centres). We will regularly share them in a specially prepared tab.
